The BERI *T* score is 58 with a percentile rank of 79 and is within the Normal Risk classification range for having or developing a behavioral or emotional problem. The IRI and SRI are also within the Normal Risk classification range. However, the PRI *T* score is 39 with a percentile rank of 15 and is within the Elevated Risk classification range. Sample reports a lack of self-confidence, unhappiness with self, and/or difficulty with their relationships with parents. Items are listed at the end of this report to identify problem behaviors that may require further attention. Additional skill development in this area may prove helpful, and additional monitoring may be needed to determine whether the problem behaviors intensify.
