Subtest(s)	Considerations
Verbal Knowledge	 Requires high-quality audio for examinee and examiner. Examiner points with the mouse to stimuli on screen. Peripheral camera/device should be placed in a stable position that shows examinee's screen and provides a view of choices made nonverbally (e.g., pointing) Examinee can use mouse or touchpad to point at choices if teleconference platform allows examiner to pass control of the mouse
Matrices	 Requires high-quality video for examinee and examiner Examiner points to stimuli on screen using mouse Peripheral camera/device should be placed in a stable position that shows examinee's screen and provides a view of choices made nonverbally (e.g., pointing) Examinee can use mouse or touchpad to point at choices if teleconference platform allows examiner to pass control of the mouse
